Emergencies & General Info	 <b>Email (Parents and Guardians)</b>	The District sends direct emails regarding emergencies, transportation delays, updates, e-newsletters, and general information to parents/guardians. Building-level communication may also be issued via email.	Parents/Guardians are automatically subscribed based on info in SISK12.
	 <b>Phone (Parents and Guardians)</b>	Calls during the school day or early morning are for emergencies or important information, such as school closings/delays or absence notices. Sedalia 200 recognizes that calls for general info can be inconvenient, so this information is typically communicated through email or social media.	Parents/Guardians are automatically subscribed based on info in SISK12.
	 <b>Text Messages (Parents and Guardians)</b>	In cases of emergencies, transportation delays, and other important/urgent information, the district sends text messages to parents/guardians. Because we are limited in characters, texts may refer the recipient to email and/or website for additional info.	Parents/Guardians are automatically subscribed based on info in SISK12.
	 <b>Web Alerts &amp; General Web Pages</b>	The District may activate the web alert system during an emergency, weather event, or the need to share important information.
